ConstructConnect announced today that the July 2024 volume of Total Nonresidential construction starts - the sum of Nonresidential Building and Heavy Engineering - was \$56.1 billion, a decrease of \$12.0 billion, or -17.6%, when compared to a revised June reading of \$68.1 billion.

Power Infrastructure Hides Otherwise Solid Month of Construction Activity

Year-to-date "YTD" Nonresidential Building construction starts totaled \$212.4 billion through July, down 11.6% from the comparable period of a year ago. July's month-on-month "MoM" results were underwhelming due in part to a \$13.3 billion decline in spending in electric power infrastructure. In the previous month, electric power infrastructure spending reached an all-time high of \$13.9 billion, more than double the previous high of \$6 billion set in 2023. This was largely the result of the June start of a \$9.8 billion energy project in Virginia. Excluding the impact of power infrastructure from July's MoM results would have propelled total nonresidential month-on-month results from a 17.6% decline to a 2% gain.

Month-on-month results for July contained many bright spots, with 13 of the 34 sub-categories tracked by ConstructConnect reporting gains. Among the leaders were Sports and Convention Centers (+263%) and Manufacturing (+135%). This was closely followed by bridges (+123%), laboratories (+80%), and libraries and museums (+57%). Power infrastructure fell 96% MoM from last month's record-high reading. The remaining categories in the bottom 5 were Offices (-54%), Military (-53%), Religious (-48%) and Elementary (-47%).

At the broader category level, July's strong stadium spending of \$11.6 billion lifted MoM Commercial starts by 21%. However, when compared to year-ago results, commercial spending was down 8.3% and fell 5.4% year-to-date. Similarly, short-term manufacturing spending was up +135% MoM, yet down -38% YoY and -41% YTD. Although Heavy Engineering was down 34% MoM, it is the only category that continues to post strong growth results when using longer-dated measures.

The Chasm in Private and Public Construction **Opportunities Continues to Widen**


At present, the spread between public and private spending is far wider than usual, given that the country is not in or coming out of a recessionary period. As recently as the end of 2023, the value of monthly nonresidential private and total public starts spending were near parity, with both sectors clocking in monthly starts spending at near \$23 billion. Since then, however public spending has soared while private spending has languished. In February 2024, private nonresidential monthly spending fell below \$15 billion for the first time in two years. However, by July, the 3-month average value of private monthly spending had recovered to \$21 billion. This is still well below the comparable pre-pandemic reading of \$26 billion in July of 2019.

In contrast, public spending has surged to record highs in 2024. In the three-month period ending July 2024, monthly public spending averaged \$33 billion. This spread between public and private spending of \$11 billion is the largest in decades outside of the gap caused by pandemic shutdowns in mid-2020. More concerning is the trend in public versus private spending since 2022. Over the last two years, monthly private spending has trended lower while public spending has accelerated.

It is hard to fathom the idea that such a divergence could be sustainable. Public spending has been fueled by levels of deficit spending seen only in war times, while private spending is expected to get a boost as interest rates begin falling, an event that could happen as early as the fourth quarter of 2024. The necessity for normalization in future sector spending should encourage firms to seek out public sector opportunities in the near term while also being mindful of the sector spending transition that will inevitably come when private demand returns.

Note: Dashed line represents the collective trend of private and public spending.


Construction Employment Update

For a third sequential month the level of total construction hiring accelerated. The total number of US construction jobs increased by 25,000 in July, representing a 130% increase over the level of construction jobs growth in the same month one year ago and a 25% increase from a month ago. July's results mark the fifth time this year that all categories of construction employment simultaneously climbed higher. The latest total construction gains were widespread, led by nonresidential building sub-trades (+11,000) and followed by residential sub-trades (+7,000) and Engineering/Civil (+3,000).

Although construction job gains have accelerated in recent months, hourly earnings growth continues to slow from its 6% annualized growth peak in late 2022. Since that peak, year-on-year earnings growth has steadily trended lower, with July's reading of 4.3% marking the slowest YoY growth in wages since September 2021. However, when looking back over the last 20 years, today's wage growth rate remains well above the longrun average of 3.0%.

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Nonresidential Construction Starts Regional Analysis

Year-to-date (YTD) regional construction activity has been generally positive for most coastal regions and yet difficult for much of mid-America. Through July, YTD construction spending expanded the fastest in the South Atlantic (+24.2%) thanks to extreme growth in Virginia and South Carolina. Collectively, these two states have reported a doubling of starts spending YTD, with total nonresidential exceeding \$40.6 billion. The second-best performing region was the Pacific, with YTD growth of 12.8%, led by Alaska (+111%) and Washington (+41%).

Across the middle of the country, results were far more austere. The West South Central region comprised of Arkansas, Louisiana, Oklahoma, and Texas fell -21.6%. YTD construction spending in the critical state of Texas has fallen by -22.6%. Texas's YTD performance is only slightly better than Louisiana's (-24.7%) and almost equal to Oklahoma's (-22.7%). As previously reported, the growth of heavy engineering across much of the country continues to offset weak nonresidential building spending.






