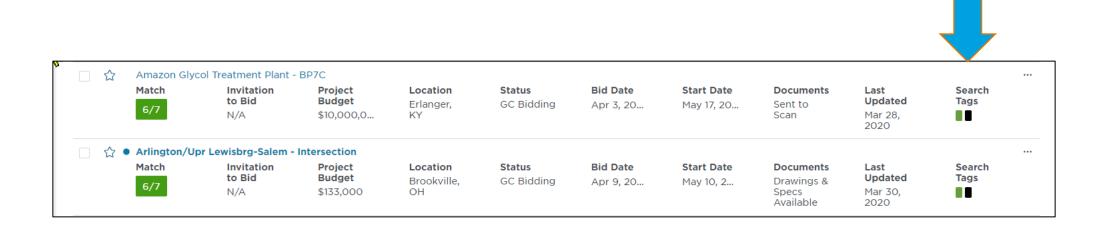

### **Defining Search Tags**

 Search tags are color markers that appear on a project that indicates this project matches multiple criteria you're looking for based on other search tags created





### **Search Tag Facts**

- You get 5 search tags with each paid user with your subscription
- Tags are a way to run multiple targeted searches at one time
- The Daily Project Email will include a notification when a new project that meets the criteria for a saved search with a tag is identified
- Your results can have multiple search tags identified depending on the criteria created
- You can only use search tags on saved searches that yield 5000 or less results
- Search Tag Benefits:
  - Quickly find the information most important to you
  - Save time searching and finding good results



### **Setting up a new Search**

To set up a search tag, you have to first, set up a search. There are 2 ways to set up a search:

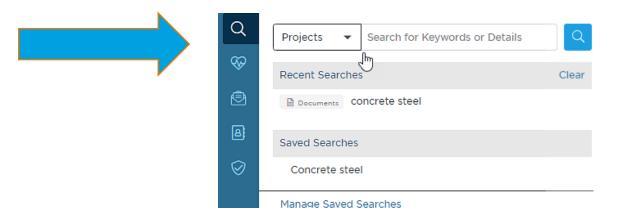
Option #1 – Use the search flyout from the navigation bar on the left to set up a new search.

#### How you get there

- Log in to ConstructConnect Project Intelligence first
- From the left side-bar menu on any page, hover over the magnifying glass icon to display the menu:

- Project documents
- Project titles
- Description
- Companies
- Recent searches
- Saved searches
- Saved Search management



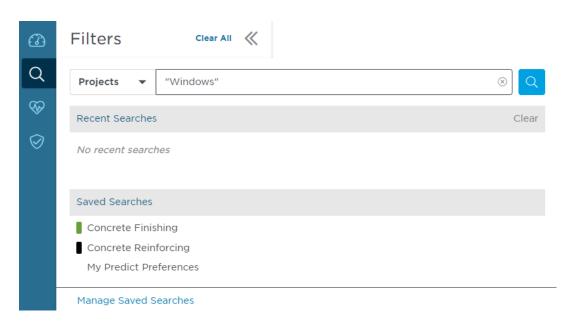


### **Setting up a new Search**

#### Use the menu

- •Use the search bar to find keywords or details in a new search and in your recent and saved searches.
- •Click **Projects** to open the project and company search menu. In the menu, you can
  - •Click to switch between projects and companies.
  - •Click **Projects** to select **Title**, **Description**, **Details** and **Documents**.
  - •Click to select an **Exact** and **Smart** search.
- •Click in the *Recent Searches* to select one of your recent searches.
- Click Managed Saved Searches to edit your saved searches.







### **Setting up a new Search**

Option #2 – You can also set up a new search by clicking on the magnifying glass.

#### How you get there

After opening the *Find Opportunities* page, click **Projects** to show the search menu:

#### You can search for...

- Projects
- Project titles
- Project Description
- Project Details
- Project Documents
- Companies

#### How you use the menu

- •Next to the search bar, click **Projects**.
- •Click the to switch between projects and companies.
- Click **Projects** to select **Title**, **Description** and **Documents**.
- •Click to select between **Exact** and **Smart** searching. (what is the difference here?)

### **Creating & Saving a Search with a Search Tag**

*Set* up a search that you would want to save and receive future updates on. *For example---* Steel Windows

- 1. Go to the magnifying glass in the Navigation bar to the left of your screen
- 2. Insert your key word (with quotation marks) ie. "Steel Windows"
- 3. Then click on the blue magnifying glass to run your search and apply filters as needed
- 4. Use the 'Save Search' icon in the top center of the screen to save your search
- 5. After giving your search a name, you can then 'Create the Search Tag' by checking the box under the search name
- 6. Save your newly created search with search tag and you are all set!



### **Saving a Search**

Next, click the **Save Search** button. In the *Save Search* menu, enter the name for the search.



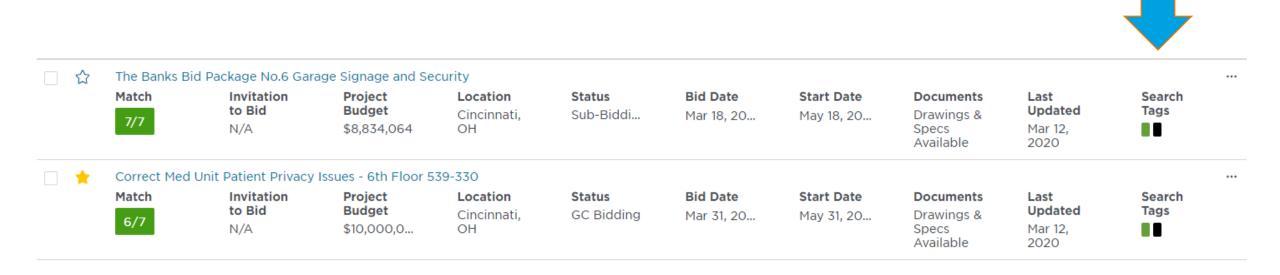

### **Search Tags Benefits**

Use them as a visual queue for the presence of a keyword in a project Use them to run multiple searches at the same time. (also called 'layering searches')
